



Additional Improvements at Hopkinson Elementary



Median on L Street improves the traffic circulationduring pick-up and drop-off hours. This prevents double parking and overtaking in the middle of the street

Raised intersection

elevates the intersection, making students crossing the street more visible to the drivers

Additional Improvements on I Street & Luzerne Street



This intersection experiences high volumes of both truck and pedestrian traffic, as it serves as a boundary between residential and industrial areas. The City proposes to have


New traffic signal to replace the stop signs **Realigned travel lanes**

Bumpouts on all four corners


Signalization Change Between M Street and I Street

- I St will recieve a new traffic signal


Existing Conditions

Additional Improvements on the Industrial Section

Median will only be placed in the industrial section. It will separate traffic going in opposite directions and reduce speeding by making the street look narrower. There will be gaps to allow driveway access.

Other things we have heard

Bike Infrastructure - Most residents do not bike in the area but are worried about people's safety when biking. The City will consider bike lanes on other streets that connect better to the bike network.

"I would love this. As a person who use to and would like to bike again, the biggest reason why I stopped is because there wasn't any safe biking lanes and cars were aggressive to bikers. I think this would be an amazing addition to the streets of philly."

Other traffic safety issues - Many residents want to see safety improvements on Hunting Park Avenue. The City will work with neighbors to improve other major roads, like Hunting Park and Whitaker.

"Please fix Hunting Park Ave between Whitaker and G Street. The work is taking too long."
