Background

The trail alignment follows the SEPTA Cynwyd Regional Rail line from 53rd St & Parkside Ave to City Avenue. The Trail will be part of the Circuit Trails Network, which is the region's nine county trail network. The Parkside Wynnefield Cynwyd Trail connects to Fairmount Park via the sidewalk & bike lanes along Parkside Avenue. Once finished, trail users will be able to travel from Fairmount Park, through the Cynwyd Heritage Trail in Bala Cynwyd, to Manayunk via the Manayunk Bridge Trail. This entirely off-road trail will be the City's first 'rail-with-trail'.




