Stroke patients with a CPSS score of 2 or 3 will be transported to a CSC.</p>	<p>PRISON SYSTEM DESTINATION: Stable pregnancy Thomas Jefferson - Main STEMI Jefferson - Torresdale Stroke Closest Appropriate Stroke Center Trauma Closest Trauma Center</p> <p>PARAMEDICS: Suspected stroke patients with a CPSS of 1 will be transported to the closest PSC or CSC. First calculate a CPSS on stroke patients. If CPSS is 2 or higher, then calculate an mRACE score. Patients with an mRACE score of 5 or greater and a last known well time of 3-24 hours will go to a CSC. Patients with an mRACE score of 4 or less will go to closest stroke center regardless of last know well.</p>
