RESPONSE:

This response assumes that “the annual TAP-R discounts” refers to the TAP-R Revenue which is intended to recover TAP discounts. Supplemental Response attachment “PLUG I-3 Supplemental Response.pdf” provides a table of the estimated TAP-R revenue by customer class for the period from January 2023 to June 2025. The attachment also provides Fiscal Year summaries for FY 2024 and FY 2025 and a summary for the 2024 TAP-R rate period (September 2024 to August 2025).

Note that Public Fire Protection is not subject to TAP-R surcharges and pays a fixed charge for fire protection capacity as established during base rate proceedings.
