

BELLS ACROSS PHILADELPHIA SCAVENGER HUNT

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SECTION 1: PROMOTION OVERVIEW

The Bells Across Philadelphia Scavenger Hunt (the “Hunt”) is a free, app-based scavenger hunt presented by the City of Philadelphia’s Office of the Mayor, through the 2026 Office, in partnership with America250PA’s Bells Across PA initiative. The Hunt is available exclusively on the 2026 Access Philly mobile application (the “App”).

The Hunt invites residents and visitors to locate artist-designed Liberty Bell replicas installed in neighborhoods across Philadelphia. Participants who find the qualifying number of bells, are entered into drawings for prizes contributed by City partners.

SECTION 2: ELIGIBILITY

- The Hunt is open to all individuals who download the 2026 Access Philly app and create a valid user account.
- Employees and immediate family members of the City of Philadelphia, America250PA, Philadelphia 250, and prize-contributing partners are not eligible for prize drawings.
- Void where prohibited by law.

SECTION 3: HUNT PERIOD

- **Launch Date:** The Hunt launches on the date announced by the City of Philadelphia through official City communications.
- **End Date:** The Hunt concludes on December 31, 2026, at 11:59 PM Eastern Time, or when all prizes have been awarded, whichever comes first.
- **Prize Drawing Deadlines:** Rolling drawings will occur throughout the Hunt period. Specific drawing dates will be announced through the App. The City reserves the right to modify drawing dates with reasonable notice.

SECTION 4: HOW TO PARTICIPATE

Step 1 — Download and Register

- Download the 2026 Access Philly app from the Apple App Store or Google Play. Search: 2026 ACCESS PHILLY.
- Create a free user account with a valid name and email address.
- Navigate to the Bells Across Philadelphia Scavenger Hunt within the app.

Step 2 — Find the Bells

- Artist designed Liberty Bell replicas are installed at locations across Philadelphia, from Overbrook Park to Tacony, Chinatown to El Centro de Oro, Germantown to the South 9th Street Corridor.

- Bell locations are revealed through the App. Participants must physically visit each bell location and check in using the App's built-in functionality.
- Each bell may only be claimed once per user account.
- GPS or location services must be enabled on the participant's device to verify physical presence at bell locations.

Step 3 — Unlock Prize Tiers

Participants are automatically entered into prize drawings upon reaching the following bell milestones:

- **5 Bells:** Entry into drawing for passes to Philadelphia cultural institutions (while supplies last).
- **10 Bells:** Entry into drawing for Le Dîner en Blanc Philadelphia and Philadelphia City Cruises experiences (while supplies last).
- **15 Bells:** First 50 eligible participants to reach this tier receive their choice of one pair of Live Nation concert tickets to eligible concerts (while supplies last).
- **25 Bells:** Entry into drawing for premium sports memorabilia, Philadelphia sports tickets, and UFC 330 tickets (while supplies last).

SECTION 5: PRIZES

- Philadelphia City Cruises: Two complimentary cruise tickets for Dinner Cruise
- Philadelphia City Cruises: Two complimentary cruise tickets for Brunch Cruise

15 Bell Tier — First Come, First Served (50 pairs available, while supplies last, to a choice of one of the following three concerts:)

- Jon Batiste: TD Pavilion at the Highmark Mann Center for Performing Arts — August 14
- Bryson Tiller: Freedom Mortgage Pavilion — September 18
- Mt. Joy: Freedom Mortgage Pavilion — September 25

Selection is subject to availability. Tickets are provided by Live Nation Northeast. One pair per eligible participant. Participants must select their preferred show at time of claim. No exchanges or substitutions after selection.

SECTION 6: PRIZE CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS

- Prizes may not be exchanged, substituted, or redeemed for cash.
- Winners are responsible for all applicable federal, state, and local taxes on prizes received.
- Prize winners will be notified by email at the address associated with their user account. Winners must respond within 72 hours of notification, or the prize will be forfeited and an alternate winner selected.
- Prizes are subject to availability. In the event a prize becomes unavailable, the City has the right, but not the obligation, to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
- Ticket and pass prizes are subject to the terms and conditions of the issuing venue or organization.
- Limit of one prize per tier per participant, unless otherwise specified.
- The City of Philadelphia is not responsible for any costs associated with prize acceptance or use, including, but not limited to, transportation, parking, or incidental expenses.
- Resale or attempted resale of tickets or passes received through the Bells Across Philadelphia Scavenger Hunt is strictly prohibited. Any winner found to have resold or attempted to resell prizes will be immediately disqualified from current and future Hunt drawings, and the City of Philadelphia reserves the right to revoke prizes and seek additional remedies as permitted by law. Tickets and passes are issued for the sole use of the winner and their designated guests and may not be transferred for commercial gain.

SECTION 7: DRAWING PROCEDURES

- Prize drawings will be conducted by the City of Philadelphia or its designee using a random selection process.
- Drawing dates and results will be announced through the App.

SECTION 8: TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS AND CONDUCT

- Participants must have a compatible smartphone with iOS or Android operating system and an active internet connection to participate.
- Location services must be enabled on the participant's device during bell check-ins. The City is not responsible for technical failures that prevent check-in.
- Each participant may maintain only one user account. Multiple accounts by the same individual will result in disqualification.
- Any attempt to use automated systems, bots, scripts, or other means to artificially accumulate bell check-ins will result in immediate disqualification.
- Participants must physically visit each bell location. Remote check-ins, GPS spoofing, or any other form of location falsification will result in disqualification.
- The City reserves the right to disqualify any participant found to be tampering with the Hunt, acting in bad faith, or violating these rules.

SECTION 9: PRIVACY AND DATA

- By participating, participants consent to the collection and use of their name, email address, and location data in accordance with the City of Philadelphia's Privacy Policy, available at phila.gov.
- Prize winners consent to the use of their name and general location (neighborhood or city) and image or photography in City communications, social media, and press materials, without additional compensation.
- Participant data will not be sold or shared with third parties except as necessary to administer the Hunt and award prizes.

SECTION 10: MODIFICATIONS AND TERMINATION

- The City of Philadelphia reserves the right to modify, suspend, or terminate the Hunt at any time, for any reason, with reasonable notice to participants through the App.
- The City reserves the right to modify these rules at any time. Updated rules will be posted on the City's website and will be effective upon posting.
- In the event of a dispute regarding these rules, the City of Philadelphia's interpretation shall be final.

SECTION 11: LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

- The City of Philadelphia, its partners including prize-contributing partners, and their respective officers, employees, and agents are not responsible for any injury, loss, or damage of any kind arising from participation in the Hunt or acceptance or use of a prize.
- The City is not responsible for lost, late, misdirected, or incomplete prize notifications.
- The City is not liable for any technical failures, errors, or malfunctions of the App or any related systems.

SECTION 12: GOVERNING LAW

The Hunt is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. These rules shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of

Pennsylvania. Any disputes arising from the Hunt shall be resolved in the courts of Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania.
