

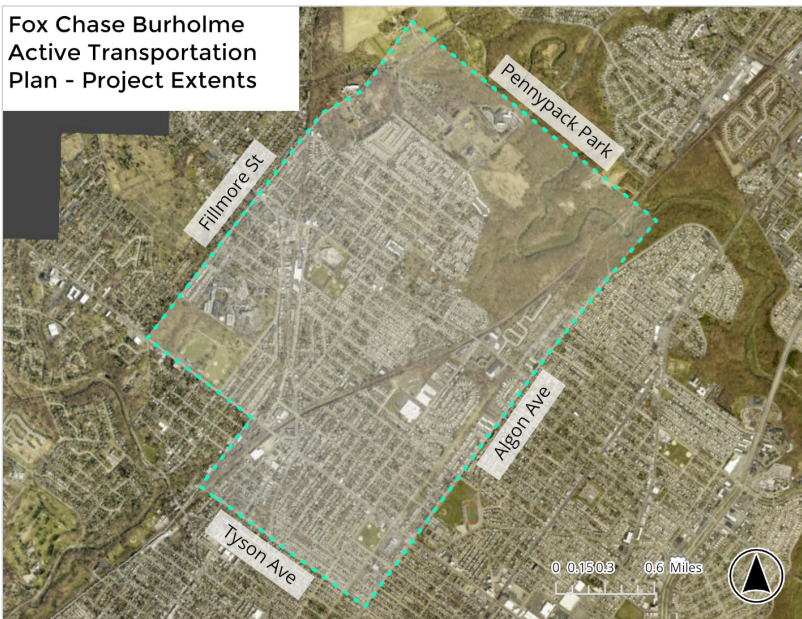

Why Fox Chase-Burholme

Fox Chase-Burholme is a vibrant community with strong local institutions, such as schools, health centers, and parks. However, pedestrian and bicycle access to these destinations is often limited by incomplete infrastructure, high-speed traffic, and gaps in connectivity.

What's Next

Over the next year, the project team will work with community members and local organizations to shape plan recommendations.

Timeline (*subject to change*):

- **Fall 2025 - Winter 2026:** Conducted existing conditions analysis
- **Spring 2026 - Summer 2026:** Begin public engagement and draft the plan
- **Fall 2026:** Finalize and release the Active Transportation Plan

The City is developing an Active Transportation Plan in Fox Chase and Burholme to

- 1) **Make road connection stronger** so people can safely walk, bike, or access transit to different destinations
- 2) **Establish a blueprint for infrastructure improvements** that enhance mobility, encourage physical activity, and improve public health outcomes
