I am writing on behalf of Philadelphia's 8th Councilmanic District to express my support for Independence Mission Schools and DePaul Catholic School in their efforts regarding the former St. Francis of Assisi Church, located at 48-60 W. Logan Street.

I understand that Independence Mission Schools has spent considerable time and resources evaluating potential options for the former church property, including rehabilitation and adaptive reuse.
