Agenda Item #4 - Active Small Cap International Equity Recommendation

Ms. Cherry said along with Staff, Marquette and the Subcommittee it is recommended an allocation from the \$250 million for this asset class be split among three managed strategies.

Ms. Cherry added a portion of the allocation will also be placed in the passive managed strategy, in part to minimize risk within the portfolio.

Thirty firms responded to the RFP on the City's website and 11 met the requirements. Along with Staff and Marquette, four managers were selected to present to the Subcommittee.

Ms. Cherry and the subcommittee recommended an initial allocation of \$25 million to Strategic Global and \$50 million each to Investors Group and AQR. In addition, there would be long term allocation ranges from \$50 to \$75 million each for the actively managed funds.

Mr. Dubow requested a motion. Mr. Rubin made a motion to accept the Sub-Committee's recommendations. Ms. Stukes-Baylor seconded. The motion passed.
